It is there to offer support and assistance or simply an attentive ear, regardless of the circumstances. It also provides students with the opportunity to form networks in areas of study relating to Law, Arts, Science, Health, Social Work and life in general.

The Program, itself, was trans-located to The Confederacy of Mainland Mi'kmaq in April 1988 from the Department of Indian Affairs.

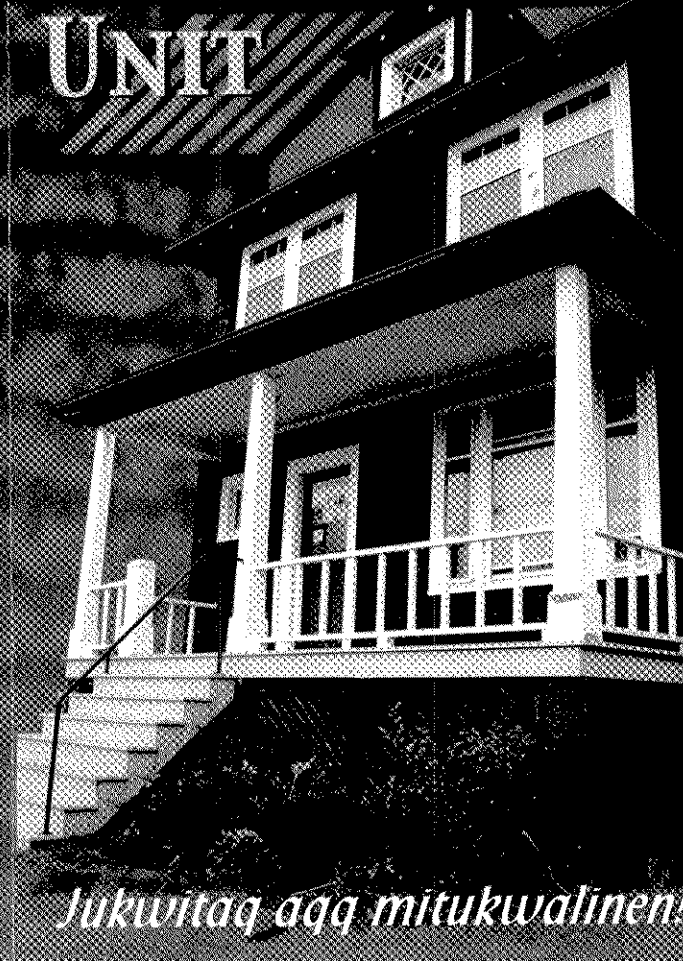

- REFERRAL TO OTHER SERVICES

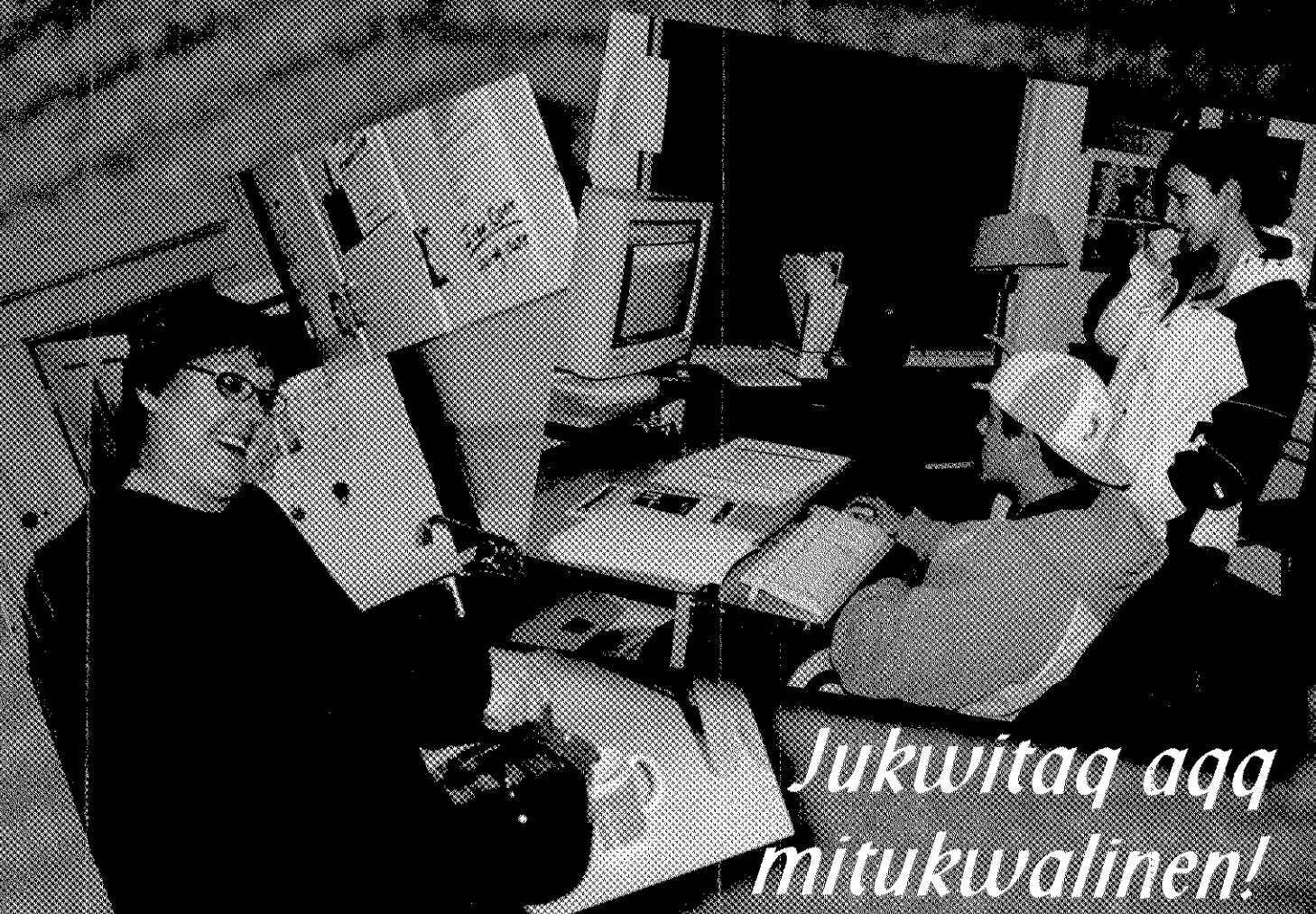
